## **Committee Descriptions**

**AR Reward Parties:** Assist with AR Reward Parties twice per year.

<u>Catholic Schools Week:</u> Help prepare and serve food for the Teacher of the Year, Honor Society Inductees' Reception, & Distinguished Graduate Reception. Organize nice notes to the teachers. \*This is 4 days out of the year in late Jan/early Feb\*

<u>Clay Shoot/Oyster Roast:</u> Help in the planning and execution of this fun event in February! This is a large committee so no one is left with a LARGE amount of work. Set up/clean up, decorate, organize the food and just have some good ol' clean fun. \*Great for Dads\*

<u>Confirmation Dinner</u>: Assist with planning, set-up and clean-up for the 8th Grade Confirmation Dinner in January.

<u>Father/Daughter Dance</u>; <u>Mother/Son Bowling</u>: Help plan and organize father/daughter, mother/son events.

<u>Girls on the Run:</u> 10 Week Program that meets 2 days a week (as set by head coach) from 3:15 – 5:00. The program starts in mid-September and concludes in November before the Thanksgiving break.

<u>Kindergarten Round-Up:</u> Assist with open house by preparing and serving refreshments. \*This is a one-day event in December\*

<u>Lunchroom Helper:</u> Assist in serving lunch weekly (flexible with your schedule). \*Great for Grandparents\*
