### **Committee Descriptions**

#### **Fundraising Committees**

#### **School Committees**

**Confirmation Dinner**: Assist with planning, set-up and clean-up for the 8th Grade Confirmation Dinner typically in February/March.

**<u>Field Day</u>**: Work closely with committee chair and PE teacher to create fun and exciting events for field day in the spring. Set up, man stations, and clean up. \*Great for Dads\*

**Girls on the Run**: \*\* WE DO NOT CURRENTLY HAVE A CHAIR FOR THIS COMMITTEE SO WE ARE LOOKING FOR THAT AS WELL\*\* 10 Week Program that meets 2 days a week (as set by head coach) from 3:15 – 5:00. The program starts in mid-September and concludes in November before the Thanksgiving break. Girls on the Run lessons encourage positive emotional, social, mental and physical development.
